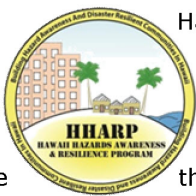


November HHARP

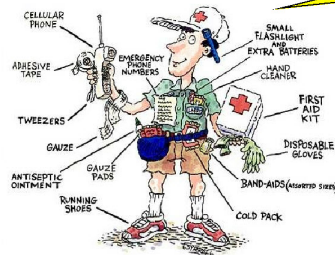
